



Mukanga is now a completely solar camp with new en-suite bathrooms and has become a popular bird safari camp in the off season for the illusive Pitta amongst other rare birds, as well as having the attraction of Dinosaur tracks.

On a brighter note, DAPU was very successful arresting and getting the convictions of several ivory poachers applying their trade outside of Dande.

As one can imagine CM Safaris is hugely indebted to all of our very generous donors, whom without their help and with no income being generated from hunting, DAPU would not have been able to continue their excellent work. A massive thank you to all of you for your kind generosity and especially to Dallas Safari Club who remain the back bone of our anti-poaching unit.
