The season is now is starting to get very busy indeed. As always Zimbabwe remains one of the easiest and safest safari destinations available. However, like all other Southern African countries we are in the throws of a terrible drought!

Luckily for us, Nyakasanga and Dande have the Zambezi and a number of springs as does Sengwa - so water is not a problem and we were fortunate enough to have a little late rain so the grass is still quite good. The issue we are already having is a huge increase in poaching which will be a countrywide problem as the locals have had a 100% crop failure. DAPU will be super busy this year and any help will be hugely appreciated!

All the hunts we have done so far have been excellent and we had wonderful results. CMS is so grateful to have a dedicated team of excellent PH that really go the extra mile for our clients and the results speak for themselves!!

We have done several early season elephant hunts ranging from Maitengwe in February to Dande, Chewore, Sengwa and Nyakasanga. I have been pleasantly surprised in the Valley at the number of older bulls we have shot! All in all an excellent start to the elephant!

















Buffalo in Nyakasanga Sengwa Dande have been outstanding. The quality of the bulls in the Valley have really improved thanks to years of anti-poaching and reduced quotas. Nearly all our buff taken so far have been dugga boys and the herds have been left alone. As the season continues we expect to take allot more wonderful trophies!















We are just starting our cat hunts now. The number of great tracks seen is very encouraging and we are expecting an amazing cat year. We have done one Kazuma which was a lion buff sable hunt and Len and our client got a beautiful lion on day 2. Kazuma remains possibly the best lion area in Zimbabwe and we still have the same hunt as below available next year so if you interested drop us an email.


